They are useful in translating the needs of the customers into performance measures that are acceptable for both the manufacturing processes and the products. Quality metrics enables the manufacturers to make Timely and sound decisions, set strategic visions, missions, and plans used to validate the manufacturing processes in pharmaceuticals.

They help in determining and assessing the manufacturing quality attributes and process parameters.

They help the manufacturers to process data, evaluate drugs quality and maintain products. Quality metrics also help the FDA develop compliance and inspection policies and practices, and inform risk-based scheduling of drug manufacturing facilities, which can result in a decrease in inspection frequency for high performers, Improve the Agency's ability to predict, and therefore, possibly mitigate, future drug shortages. He stressed that Quality metrics Provide additional intelligence to inform FDA's comprehensive surveillance program, encourage implementation of state-of-the-art, innovative quality management systems for pharmaceutical manufacturing.
