They help in determining and assessing the manufacturing quality attributes and process parameters.

They help the manufacturers to process data, evaluate drugs quality and maintain products. Quality metrics also help the FDA develop compliance and inspection policies and practices, and inform risk-based scheduling of drug manufacturing facilities, which can result in a decrease in inspection frequency for high performers, Improve the Agency's ability to predict, and therefore, possibly mitigate, future drug shortages. He stressed that Quality metrics Provide additional intelligence to inform FDA's comprehensive surveillance program, encourage implementation of state-of-the-art, innovative quality management systems for pharmaceutical manufacturing.

Open access is part of a wider 'open' movement to encourage free exchange of knowledge and resources in order to widen access and encourage creativity. He explained about

When research is held behind a publisher's pay wall, this restricts access to only those who can afford it. Anyone can benefit from wider access to research, from small businesses to schools.

These benefits have led to many funders requiring outputs of the research they fund to be made available open access.
