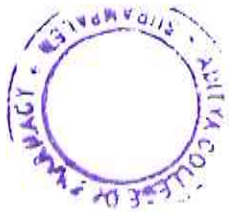

Description about the Event:

He explained about that the documents to be submitted to regulatory authorities have almost tripled in the last ten years. In addition, regulatory authorities now take much longer to approve a new drug. Consequently, the period of patent protection is reduced, resulting in the need of putting in extra efforts to earn enough profits. The situation may be more severe in the case of drugs developed through the biotechnology route especially those involving utilization of genes. It is likely that the industrialized world would soon start canvassing for longer protection for drugs. It is also possible that many governments would exercise more and more price control to meet public goals. This would on one hand emphasize the need for reduced cost of drug development, production, and marketing, and on the other hand, necessitate planning for lower profit margins so as to recover costs over a longer period. It is thus obvious that the drug industry has to wade through many conflicting requirements. Many different strategies have been evolved during the last 10 to 15 years for cost containment and trade advantage. Some of these are out sourcing of R&D activity, forming R&D partnerships and establishing strategic alliances. He explained about

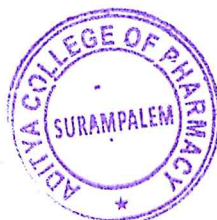
Description about the event:

He explained in detailed about before filing a patent application can have a profound influence on patent strategies and outcomes. Not only can understanding prior art help to determine whether an invention is patentable, but it can also inform how a patent application should be drafted to reduce the risk that it will be rejected by the USPTO. He explained the Prior art, as it pertains to a single patent application, includes anything that is known to the public before the application is filed with the patent office. In other words, any public information that predates a patent filing falls into the category of "prior art." This includes foreign and domestic patent documents, whether they are pending, granted, expired, rejected or abandoned. For an invention to be patentable, it must benewandat the time a patent application is filed that claims the invention. It is the job of patent examiners to comb through and evaluate an invention's novelty and nonobviousness based on all prior art in the world. He explained about some platform for managing prior art.

He explained about what is the importance of Hatch-Waxman Act patent law and product development formally known as the Drug Price Competition and Patent Term Restoration Act is a law passed in 1984 that created the generic drug industry as we know it today in the United States. He discussing about the Hatch-Waxman Act provides incentives for generic drug companies to challenge patents owned by innovators, and it gives generics a research exemption that allows them to develop generic drugs while patents for the brand are still in force without being liable for infringement. He explained about Hatch-Waxman also has some provisions that are favorable to innovators. Innovator drug companies now enjoy a period of FDA regulatory inclusivity, normally five years for a new product, during which the FDA will not approve a generic. In addition, Hatch-Waxman gives innovators a potential five-year patent term extension. For a number of big drugs, these periods of inclusivity have been worth billions of dollars.
